## **Agree to meet.**

Short description: Agree on a time to meet. Even when you can't see their schedule.

Long description: You can't see their schedule. They can't see yours. With Invite, groups agree on a time to meet—then get it on their calendars.

### **Know thyself**

Before you suggest times to meet, check your availability. Your calendar is right there. Available when you create and reply to an invite. Bye, bye double-booking.

### **Ask first, then decide**

Organizers suggest times to meet. Invitees pick the times that work for them. Now you're all set to make a decision.

### **Count your RSVPs**

From your phone or the web, Invite is right there with you. See the replies roll in, real-time.

### **Book it**

You've agreed on a date & time, now what? Get the event on your calendars, of course. Invite is fluent in most calendar languages. Send. Accept. Wa-lah! Their time is booked.
